I. Approval of Minutes of February 26, 2002

II. Update on Parking Garage Repairs

Greg DuBois reported that repairs are being done to the five garages located around the Health Center. Garage One will be repaired starting Monday, January 20, 2003. The repairs will be done level by level starting at the top level. Bridging will be allowed over to Garage Ten to add additional parking spaces to replace the ones being repaired. Bridging back and forth will be possible as each level is repaired. The budget for this repair work is \$400,000. A mass e-mail has been sent out plus notices will be posted in the garages affected by the repairs.

The repairs being made to Garage Six at the 1329 Building are being done at night. Additional lighting is being added. A small number of spaces are being blocked off during the day as needed for the repairs.

Garage Three is being repaired over spring break. Possible closure of spaces may be necessary for making the needed repairs. Additional spaces will be made available in visitor parking if closure of spaces in Garage Three becomes necessary.

Jerry Kidney suggested that physical locations be added to notices giving information on any of the garages as some people may not be able to recognize which garage is being referred to when only the numbers are used.

III. Motorcycle Parking for Cancer Center Employee

Scott Fox, Assistant Director of Transportation and Parking, received a letter from Dr. Russell Hinerman, Assistant Professor, Department of Radiation Oncology, requesting a designated motorcycle parking spot adjacent to the Cancer Center building on SW Archer Road. In this letter he outlined his duties and reasoning for requesting such a designation. It was stated that there is an under-used, covered designated motorcycle parking area in the parking garage closest to the Cancer Center. It was also stated that the walk from that area to where Dr. Hinerman is requesting the designated area is under three minutes. Discussion ensued concerning the ramifications of granting this request, not the least of which would be setting a precedent.

**MOTION: Dr. Ronald Gronwall moved that the committee recommend that Dr. Hinerman park in the designated motorcycle parking area already provided in Parking Garage Three.**

#### **IV. Other Business**

Greg Dubois reported that the triangle lot west of the helicopter facility would be lighted. Shealy Drive will be getting sidewalks. The west entrance to the JHMHC, DSB main entrance, needs to be lighted more and studies are being done as to the most economical way to accomplish this and where the funding will originate. The Vet Med lot will be paved in the near future.

There being no further business Michael Nyland made a motion to adjourn the meeting.
