I. Approval of Minutes of February 26, 2002

MOTION: Robert Miller moved to approve the minutes of February 26, 2002.

II. Construction Impact to Old ER Lot

A discussion ensued involving the various parking lots surrounding the JHMHC. As more areas are secured parking needs will increase. The use of the lower level of Garage 10 will change as the HPNP Building is completed. Some state vehicles will be moved from the lower level of Garage 10 to the limerock lot near Building 62. The old ER lot is presently being used by Shands for Ajax Construction as a construction lot and has one handicapped space. Gerald Kidney requested one space in this area for the Vice President's office. The gates to the area cannot be locked as it is a fire exit. Electronic bollards are to be installed in the future to secure this area.

MOTION: Brad Pollitt moved to allow this area to be used by Shands as a construction lot for Ajax Construction during the current renovation and to leave one space for handicapped parking and one space for the Vice President's office.

III. Additional Parking at 1329 Building for Visitors and Employment Activities

Further discussion on the 1329 Building parking was conducted. Michael Nyland reported that 6 additional metered spaces with a longer time limit are needed. Robert Miller stated that the additional metered spaces would be easy to accomplish.

MOTION: Robert Miller moved to increase the current number of metered spaces in Parking Garage 6 by a number arrived at by Michael Nyland and Steve Truluck. The number of gated spaces in Parking Garage 6 will remain the same. This will decrease the number of Blue 1 spaces in Parking Garage 6.
